CONCORD, NH – On November 19, 2015 at approximately 7:30 PM the Concord Police Department responded to the area of North State Street and Clark Street for a report of a distraught man who pointed a shotgun at a pizza delivery man.

The victim reported that he delivered food to a multi-family apartment building located on North State Street. Upon arrival he made contact with the male occupant and noticed that he was intoxicated. While completing the transaction, the deliveryman said that the male in question made statements that he did not care if he lived or died.

At some point following this, the male went into another room and retrieved what appeared to be a shotgun. The deliveryman reported that the male then pointed the gun directly at him while walking towards him (the deliveryman). At some point the male in question asked the deliveryman if he wanted to handle or hold the shotgun. When the deliveryman declined to do so, the male in question sat down on a chair and “racked” the gun. Shortly after this, the deliveryman exited the apartment and called the police.

Concord Police Officers surrounded the residence in an attempt to secure the area and to make contact with the male in question. While doing this, Concord PD was contacted by multiple civilians who were familiar with the male. The male in question was identified as,

One of these civilians was able to make contact with Martin via phone and asked him to exit the home without the gun. Martin did as he was asked, exiting the building and surrendering to police. A shotgun was later recovered by Concord PD.

Martin was arrested and charged with

**Reckless Conduct; Place Another in Danger (RSA 631:3/Class B Fel)**  
**Criminal Threatening (Use of a Deadly Weapon) (RSA 631:4,II2-1/Class B Fel)**

Martin was later ordered held on \$10,000.00 cash bail and will be arraigned this morning at the 6th Circuit – District Division – Concord (Concord District Court) this morning (Nov 20, 2015) at 11:00 AM.
