ON-LINE VEHICLE REGISTRATION

The City is now offering citizens a faster, more convenient way to renew their vehicle registrations. Residents may now renew their vehicle registrations on-line - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week - by using **E-Reg**. E-Reg streamlines and simplifies the entire process and accepts payment by credit card or E-check.

In addition to the motor vehicle renewal registration fee, the following fees will apply:

- For E-check payments, a \$1.50 process fee per vehicle, plus a \$1.50 ACH flat fee will apply.
- For credit/debit card payment, a \$1.50 processing fee per vehicle, plus a convenience fee equal to 2.95% of the transaction amount (minimum \$1.50) will apply.

To access **E-Reg**, go to www.concordnh.gov/ereg and provide the required information from your current registration.

For those who still wish to visit the Collections Office to process their vehicle registrations, they now accept Visa, MasterCard and Discover credit cards, with a convenience fee equal to 2.95% of the total transaction cost. For added convenience, the City has extended their hours open to the public until 6:00 PM on Thursdays.


Beaver Meadow is scheduled to open their driving range on Saturday, March 30th.
