NOTICE OF CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD

Residents wishing to file for State Representative or Delegate to the Republican State Convention may do so in the City Clerk's Office. The filing period for the September 14, 2010 State Primary Election began on June 2, 2010 and runs through June 11, 2010. The filing fee to run for State Representative is \$2.00. There is no fee to run as a Delegate to the Republican State Convention. Residents wishing to file to run for any other State office may do so at the Secretary of State's Office. Filings are accepted at the City Clerk's Office, Monday through Friday, between 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM. The City Clerk's Office will stay open until 5:00 PM on the last day of filing. NORTH STATE STREET IMPROVEMENTS

With the section of North State Street and Knight Street newly base paved, the contractor will now focus efforts on resetting vertical granite street curbing, addressing driveways and building sidewalks. The Personnel Department just completed three hectic weeks of Beneflex Open Enrollment. Open enrollment is the time of year when employees have an opportunity to make changes to their benefit elections.
